

## Society of Colonial Wars plaque



Location: On the Cathedral's West Front – near the entrance to South Road

The bronze plaque is mounted on a granite boulder. It was dedicated in 1907 and donated by the Society of Colonial Wars.

Inscription:

This Memorial  
Was Erected In 1907  
By The Society Of Colonial Wars  
In The District Of Columbia  
To Mark The Road Over Which  
On April 14, 1755  
A Division Of The British Army  
Under General Braddock  
Marched On Its Way  
To Fort Duquesne
